











GENERAL SAFETY INSTRUCTIONS

- Inspect before each use for damaged and loose fasteners/connections.
- Inspect the product for cracks, wear or damage. Replace damaged components immediately.
- Keep hands and feet away from all moving parts.
- Operate safely; go only as fast as safety considerations allow.
- Do not use this product to transport people.
- Do not drive off curbs or high ledges.
- Never use it on a moving vehicle.
- Always stand beside the hand truck, walking forward while operating in reverse.
- Never walk backwards with the hand truck.
- Never exceed the rated capacity, especially on ramps or hills. Doing so could cause damage to the hand truck and injury to personnel.










INSTRUCTIONS FOR USE

- When loading hand trucks, keep your feet clear of the wheels.
- Do not exceed the manufacturer's load-rated capacity; read the capacity plate on the hand truck if you are unsure.
- Place the load so it will not slip, shift or fall; use the straps, if provided, to secure the load.
- For extremely bulky or pressurized items such as gas cylinders, strap or chain the items to the hand truck.
- Tip the load slightly forward so that the tongue of the hand truck goes under the load
- Push the tongue of the hand truck under the load that is to be moved.
- Keep the load's centre of gravity as low as possible by placing heavier objects below the lighter ones.
- Push the load so the axle, not the handles, will carry the weight.
- If your view is obstructed, ask a spotter to assist in guiding the load.
- Do not walk backwards with the hand truck unless going upstairs or on ramps.
- When going down an incline, keep the hand truck in front of you so it can be controlled at all times.
- Move hand trucks at a walking pace.
- Store hand trucks with the tongue under a pallet, shelf, or table.

INSPECTIONS, MAINTENANCE AND REPAIR

- Before each use, check for damaged or missing components. Replace broken or missing pieces immediately with Aardwolf replacement parts.
- Check all fasteners, and make sure to tighten or replace loose or missing hardware.
- Check welds and material near welds for cracking or damage.
- Make sure that the pneumatic wheels are correctly inflated.
- Store the hand truck in good condition to increase its life.

WARRANTY

At the time of delivery, it is necessary to check that the clamp has not been damaged during shipment. Any claims must be presented within eight days of the product's delivery date.

We grant you one year warranty on the Aardwolf Hand Truck counted from the date of purchase.

The warranty coverage is not applicable if:

- The hand truck is mishandled during manoeuvring.
- The operator fails to comply with the instructions in this booklet.
- The product's maximum permissible capacity is exceeded.
- The specifications for the hand truck are not followed.
- Damages are due to inadequate maintenance and inspections.
- Damage is due to improper storage.
- The user performed repairs without our permission.
- The user uses non-original spare parts from the Aardwolf brand.
